

TECHNE studentships at Roehampton

Roehampton is the most research-intensive new university in the UK. We are home to nearly four hundred research students across our academic Schools, supported by the Graduate School and our Research and Knowledge Exchange (RKE) centres.

Roehampton hosts a thriving community of over forty TECHNE research students engaged in projects ranging from exploring black women's mental health organising in the 1970s to 'Posthuman' Poetics. Much of the work undertaken by our research students is practice-led and many of our TECHNE researchers work in collaboration with external partners such as the Black Cultural Archives, the Royal Botanical Gardens, Kew and Sadler's Wells. The research of our TECHNE students is integral to major Roehampton research projects on the early modern stage and wealth and poverty in seventeenth-century England. Working with our expert supervisors at Roehampton, our TECHNE students have gone on to produce award-winning research monographs and showcase their creative work at major international festivals such as the Berlin Biennale.
